2000 Match Point Ministries (501 c3) was co-founded by Scott Williams and Ryan Fitzwilliam to lead tennis players to Jesus Christ becoming one of the first active tennis ministries in the United States.

2002 Scott Williams authored Serious Tennis book with Human Kinetics publishing and partnered with Gold Coast Fellowship of Christian Athletes to organize and run tennis camps distributing FCA bibles.

2003 Match Point Ministries runs its first Professional Tennis Tournament co-partnering with Daniel Chapter One.

2006 Spiritually Tough Tennis summer camps begin with 50 students for 11 weeks. Daily Heart of an Athlete FCA devotionals/ invitations to Christ given. New souls saved weekly for Jesus.

2008 MPM partners with FCA to host First Annual Celebrity Golf and Tennis Classic in Boca Raton.

2009 MPM inaugural Prayer Breakfast with Pros at Delray Beach ATP Tour event. Bryan Brothers award winners.

2011-12 The 3rd Annual Breakfast with the Ace Pro awards and family clinic with former Top 5 ATP Pro, David Wheaton. Coach Scott Williams leads boys and girls teams to several Florida State Championships. Authors his second book with Joey Rive titled “Skills and Drills” published by Human Kinetic Publishers.

2014 MPM partner with Grace Place in Ft. Lauderdale. A group of ten at-risk teens join us for two weeks participating in soccer and tennis. FCA bibles are given to the teens. Eight of the teens accept Christ into their hearts!

MPM holds the 8th annual Celebrity Golf and Tennis Classic with Keynote Speaker Wally Armstrong and hosted by NFL/NCAA player Michael Blanc with former top professional tennis players, Roscoe Tanner, Van Winitsky and Brenda Schultz-McCarthy playing in the event.

2015 Coach Williams travels on the Men’s Pro Tour again with Tommy Haas. Coach Williams also coaches team Florida to a Bronze medal finish at the Nationals in Auburn, Alabama.

Full Time Boarding & Non Boarding Program

Objectives: *Develop Christian Leaders that compete to win championships for Jesus Christ!*

The Full Time Boarding Tennis Academy Program at The King's Academy is an intensive training commitment in Mind, Body, and Spirit. Through a daily regimen of spiritual, technical, tactical, mental, and physical training, every aspect of a player's game will be addressed.

The morning sessions will be dedicated to:

- **Spiritually:** Growing in God's word, applying those lessons to the student's lives and journaling to determine what God is preparing or asking them to do. All students will be provided a spiritual talents and gifts assessment as well.
- **Technically:** Each player in the full time boarding program receives a daily (Semi-Private) Young Pro In Training Session (YPIT) 1.5 hour (valued at \$400.00) with Coach Scott Williams.
- **Tactically:** Each player will develop patterns of play, options, runway usage, and weapon development based on their own strengths and weaknesses.
- **Mentally:** Players will be taught how to develop their "soft focus" of quickly seeing and assessing where they are on the court, what type of ball they are receiving, and where their opponent is to quickly determine which phase of play is best suited for that situation.

The afternoon sessions will be dedicated to:

- **Spiritually:** Learning how to compete at your highest level possible while giving God the glory for both your successes and failures.
- **Technically & Tactically:** Learning how to apply your morning workouts in point, game, and set play in singles and doubles.
- **Mentally & Emotionally:** Competing with an attitude of gratitude and then learning how to recover mentally and emotionally to achieve your best performances
- **Physically:** Developing your strength, speed endurance, explosiveness on the court, and flexibility. Learning about what your nutritional needs are.

Build four (4) asphalt tennis courts (QuickStart) each measuring 40' x 80'. Atop your properly prepared sub base we will install 6" rock base laser graded, compacted and primed, and pave with 1" Type S-3 Virgin hot mix asphalt. Install 4 pair net post footers with PVC sleeves. After +/- 14 day asphalt cure time fine patch surface and apply 4 coat acrylic color system, including 2 coats of Laykold NuSurf acrylic resurfacer, 2 coats of Tropicoat® acrylic court paint and 60' 10-and-under regulation playing lines to USTA specifications. Install net posts and nets.

Fencing -- \$19,500

Prepare the sub base for (4) 40' x 80' pad installation. Strip grass, remove eight (8) 15' tall trees, add 6" fill laser graded and compacted to 98% density. Haul off site all wastes.

Sub Base & Pad Installation -- \$16,800

Prepare the sub base for (4) 40' x 80' pad installation. Strip grass, remove eight (8) 15' tall trees, add 6" fill laser graded and compacted to 98% density. Haul off site all wastes.

Resurface Tennis Courts -- \$22,700

Resurface six (6) asphalt tennis courts in one battery measuring 156' x 240'. Pressure clean and flood surface as needed; patch low areas greater than +/- 1/8"; patch wider cracks; apply 3 coat acrylic color system, including 1 coat of Laykold acrylic resurfacer, 2 coats of Tropicoat® acrylic court paint and playing lines to USTA specifications. Paint 4 sets of blended color lines consisting of basketball keys and 3-point lines. Repaint net posts. A 3 year workmanship guarantee is offered with this work
